National Testing Agency has been mandated by the **Ministry of Education and UGC** to conduct Common University Entrance Test (CUET) for admission into **Undergraduate Programmes** in **Central Universities under Ministry of Education, and other participating Universities / Institutions / Organizations / Autonomous Colleges**.

CUET (UG) will provide a single window opportunity to students seeking admission in any of the Central Universities (CUs) or other participating organizations (including State Universities, Deemed and Private Universities) across the Country.

For the Academic Session 2023-24, CUET (UG) – 2023 will be conducted in the Computer Based Test (CBT) mode as per the details given below:

- 2. Examination will be conducted on multiple days in three shifts, depending on the number of Candidates and Subject choices.

- i. Candidates can apply for CUET (UG) 2023 through the "Online" mode only on the website <a href="https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/">https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/</a> The Application Form in any other mode will not be accepted.
- ii. Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate. In no circumstances, candidates will be allowed to fill more than one Application Form. Strict action will be taken, even at a later stage, against such candidates who have filled more than one Application Form.
- iii. Candidates must strictly follow the instructions given in the Information Bulletin and on the website <a href="https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/">https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/</a> . Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.
- iv. Candidates must ensure that the **e-mail address and Mobile Number** provided in the Online Application Form are their own or Parents/Guardians only as all information/ communication will be sent by NTA through e-mail on the registered e-mail address or SMS on the registered Mobile Number only.
